The play scripts will be judged in the following areas:

- Story plot and its originality
- Use of language
- Creativity in character development

For Radio Drama:

The contestants' performance in the radio drama will be judged in the following areas:

- Articulation
- Voice projection
- Expressiveness
- Creativity in building characters through use of voice
- Thoughtful use of sound effects
- Team work and cooperation
